

Travel Information for Guests

Hampton Court Palace, KT8 9AU

By car

The palace is located on the A308 and is well signposted from all the major local roads; drivers should follow the brown tourist attraction road signs. From the M25 take either exit 10 on to the A307 or exit 12 on to the A308. The palace is also accessible via the A3 and then the A309.

Guests must show their invitation to the member of staff on Trophy Gate to gain entry into the car park. The exit barrier will be raised for the end of the event allowing guests to park free of charge. If the palace car park is full then please use the following alternatives:

The Green Car Park

This car park is situated along Hampton Court Road, opposite the petrol station, only 500m from the palace. The car park charge is £1.50 per hour and is pay and display. The Green car park will remain open until midnight.

The Station Car Park

Parking is also available at the Hampton Court train station, 200m from the palace. Please check at the station for prices.

Please note that overnight parking is not available at the palace. Should this be required then please use the train station car park.

By taxi

Taxi drop off and collection are from the Palace carpark. Please ensure that any pre-booked cars are informed that they must wait within the Palace carpark for guests. Please find below a list of local taxi companies;

By train

South West Trains run services direct from London Waterloo to Hampton Court. The journey only takes 35 minutes and the palace is a 200m walk across the bridge from the station. The train service passes through Wimbledon station, where the London Underground District Line begins. Trains also call at Vauxhall, Clapham Junction, Earlsfield, Wimbledon, Raynes Park, New Malden, Berrylands, Surbiton and Thames Ditton. Train times are as follows:
